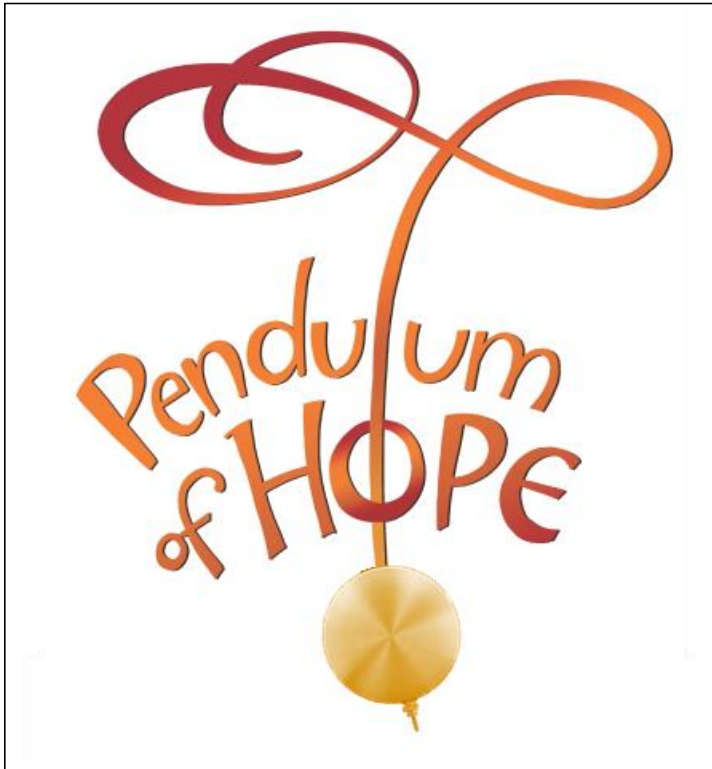


Community Education Offered by Hospice of the Northwest
