

Transitions Program



Lumina Hospice & Palliative Care provides compassion, comfort and support to Mid-Willamette Valley residents facing a serious illness or difficult medical decisions. We help patients live out the rest of their lives on their own terms, among people who care. Founded as Benton Hospice Service in 1980, we are the recognized regional source for the continuum of end-of-life services. We built our reputation on a commitment to promote dignity, respect choices, ease suffering and honor the grieving process.

What is Transitions?

Transitions is a non-medical program for individuals who are living with serious illness. We offer assistance navigating this difficult time, with companionship, compassion, and connection to community resources. The program is provided free of charge. It is funded through grants and donations, and a community of volunteers who help support the Transitions program.

Who Is Eligible For Transitions?

Anyone who has a life-limiting illness can use Transitions, whether or not they are receiving active treatment for an illness. Call Transitions for help if someone you know is dealing with a life-limiting illness and:

- ◆ Needs help planning for increased care needs
- ◆ Is having trouble managing the activities of daily life
- ◆ Chooses to pursue treatment rather than seeking only comfort care
- ◆ Is feeling isolated or lonely
- ◆ Needs help finding community services in order to maintain independence
- ◆ Could use support for a caregiver in need of a break

Hospice Care

A supportive approach to end-of-life care provided at the patient's residence

End-of-Life Education

Support to the community through training, lectures and presentations

Palliative Care Consults

Clinical guidance for medical providers and patients to assist with symptom management and advance care planning

For those caring for a family member or friend through a chronic or terminal illness

Palliative Care

Case Management

An interdisciplinary medical program for patients living with a serious or chronic illness who are not yet ready for hospice

Grief Support

To anyone in the mid-Willamette Valley who is impacted by death
